



# **Become a member of the City of Windcrest 2020 Census Complete Count Committee.**

We are looking for volunteers to serve as “census ambassadors” that will play an integral part in ensuring a complete and accurate count of the community in the 2020 Census. The overall success of the 2020 Census is dependent on community involvement and participation.

## **Why do we need a Complete Count Committee?**

- Increase the self-response rate for households responding online, by phone, or mailing back their questionnaire through a focused, structured, neighbor-to-neighbor program.
- Bring together a cross section of community members whose focus is 2020 Census awareness.

## **What is the structure of a Complete Count Committee?**

Ideal candidates for the Complete Count Committee (CCC) are those community members who have expertise, influence, and experience in the area of the respective committee. The Committee shall consist of 9 members and may include representation from each of the following groups within the City of Windcrest: (1) Business; (2) Education; (3) Faith-Based Groups; (4) Government; (5) Senior Citizen Organizations; (6) Youth Organizations; (7) Healthcare; (8) Media.

## **Will there be training?**

Yes, the U.S. Census Bureau will provide initial training to the committee as well as support resources. Census2020.gov provides the CCC plenty of promotional materials to utilize. As a Census 2020 partner, the City will assist with the CCC efforts.
